

ANEMONE x HYBRID

LUCKY Charm



The common name for Anemone is Windflower. Lucky Charm adds more “seasonality” due to its characteristics. Initially, the tops and undersides of Lucky Charm’s leaves are a dark violet color. As the leaves mature, the topsides turn to a darker than normal green, and the undersides to a lighter violet. The stems are dark purple, almost black, while the flower buds are a medium violet. Lucky Charm’s flowers are darker pink than September Charm, and are excellent mid- to-late season flower color.

BOTANICAL NAME -- Anemone x hybrid ‘Lucky Charm’

COMMON NAME -- Lucky Charm Windflower

USDA ZONES -- 5 to 8

10 YEAR SIZE -- 30-36”H x 20”W

HABIT -- Mounding (slightly more compact than Anemone ‘September Charm’)

CULTURE -- Partial shade
