

A spiny, semi-climbing, upright shrub, with arching, cane-like branches, 5-Leaf Variegated Aralia is a great choice for that spot in your garden where nothing else will grow! Tough and hardy, it does well in most soil types, in shade to filtered light, with modest water, and is deer resistant. It's 5-fingered, palmate leaves are bright green, edged and splashed with luscious, creamy white variegations. Umbrellas of small, starshaped, greenish-white flowers appear May through June. Excellent in shade gardens, wood-land settings, and shrub borders, or as foundation planting.

Eleutherococcus sieboldianus Variegatus

- HABIT: Upright, semi-climbing, deciduous shrub; arching, cane-like branches; 6-8'W x 6-8'H
- **CULTIVATION:** USDA 4-9; tolerant of most soil types; medium to low water; shade to filtered light
- **FOLIAGE:** Palmate, compound, green leaves with creamy white edges and variegations; small umbrellas of starshaped flowers May to June
