CALYCANTHUS

Also known as Eastern Sweetshrub, these gorgeous, deciduous shrubs impress with lush, coarse-textured foliage, and abundant flowers, that are valued for their fragrance and form. Calycanthus will grow to about 8 feet tall x 5 feet wide, and prefers deep, moist but well-drained, loamy soil. Planted in part shade, its growth rate is moderate – slightly slower if planted in full sun. In late spring to early summer, Calycanthus is covered in a profusion of strongly-scented, lotus-shaped flowers, resembling small magnolia blossoms.

HARTLAGE WINE

A hybrid of Asian Calycanthus (Sinocalycanthus) chinensis and our native Calycanthus floridus, Hartlage Wine retains the best characteristics of both parents. Large, raspberry to wine-red flowers open widely from early April to late May, filling the garden with subtle fragrance. The large, medium green leaves add bold texture. Vigorous, very floriferous, and extremely showy! USDA zone 5.
