

# CARPENTERIA CALIFORNICA *Elizabeth*



Better known as California Mock Orange, Elizabeth Tree Anemone, or Bush Anemone, *Carpenteria californica* 'Elizabeth' is native to the dry granite ridges in the foothills of the southern Sierra Nevada, in the Central Valley near Fresno, California. Because of the demanding conditions of its natural habitat,

*Carpenteria* 'Elizabeth' possesses many attributes, including drought tolerance, deer and gopher resistance, ability to thrive in poor (non-clay) soil, and oak root rot resistance. *Carpenteria californica* is an excellent choice for planting en masse, in rock gardens or under oaks.

- 5+'H x 5+'W at ten years
- Erect habit
- Plant in full sun to partial shade in well-drained soil.
- Large, white petals surrounding bright yellow stamens
- Gorgeous flaking bark
- 3 to 4-inch evergreen leaves are glossy dark green on top, with silvery undersides
