LONICERA CAERULEA / EDIBLE HONEYSUCKLE / HONEYBERRY

Lonicera caerulea, also known as Honeyberry, is a unique tasting fruit, high in antioxidants. It is extremely hardy, easy to grow and vigorous, and it tolerates a wide range of exposures, soil types and pH levels. Haskap Berry fruit resembles a cross between a long grape and a blueberry, and may be used in jams, preserves, baked goods and juice, or eaten fresh. Planting three varieties, including a pollinator, in a single container is a great way to introduce and promote this small fruit to your customers.

HASKAP ESSENTIALS

Botanical Name: *Lonicera caerulea*

Common Name: Honeyberry, Edible Honeysuckle, Haskap

USDA Hardiness: Zones 2 to 8

Mature Size: 4' to 8' tall

Habit: Deciduous, fruit bearing shrub

Culture: Full to part sun; rich, moist but well-drained soil; tolerant to acidic soils

Features:

- Extremely hardy and fast growing
- Higher in antioxidants than blueberries
- High yielding; one mature shrub can produce 7 to 10 lbs.
- Disease and pest resistant; easy to grow organically
