



Strawberry ICE

This new twist on the long-popular evergreen shrub, is not your grandmother's Photinia! 'Strawberry Ice' brightens the landscape with strawberry red new growth and distinctive, variegated foliage. Leathery, finely serrated leaves emerge red, in a showy display lasting 2 to 3 weeks, then gradually change to green with creamy variegations. Small, white flowers born on wide panicles dot 'Strawberry Ice' late April to May. Plant in medium moisture, well-drained soil, in full sun to part shade. Makes a statement as a specimen, or shrubby hedge.
